



**UPDATE:** We are continuing to follow guidance from the Equine Disease Communication Center, our veterinary team, and state authorities. The show will proceed as planned unless conditions materially change. For full context and reasoning, please review on our website.

As before, the 55 horses that were quarantined at HITS Culpeper are not allowed to attend the upcoming Beverly show. As a condition of entry, and in alignment with industry best practices, all horses entering the show grounds must provide proof of current vaccination.

### **Health Requirements – Equine Vaccination Policy**

After consultation with veterinarians, this competition is proceeding as scheduled. As a condition of entry, and in alignment with industry best practices, all horses entering the show grounds must provide proof of current vaccination.

#### **Required Vaccinations:**

- Equine Influenza (Flu)
- Equine Herpesvirus (Rhinopneumonitis / EHV-1 & EHV-4)

#### **Timing Requirement:**

- Vaccinations must be administered within six (6) months prior to arrival on the show grounds.

#### **Acceptable Proof of Vaccination:**

- A veterinary invoice or receipt indicating:
  - Horse's name
  - Date of administration
  - Vaccines administered
- Or a completed United States Equestrian Federation Vaccination Record Form

#### **Compliance:**

- Proof of vaccination must be available upon request and may be required prior to entry approval or at check-in.
- Horses not in compliance with these requirements may be denied entry to the show grounds.

*These requirements reflect standard biosecurity protocols consistent with USEF-licensed competitions.*
