### **Rules**

- ♦ A total of 15—20 rides will be accepted for the show
- All Divisions will run as Open unless entries are sufficient to divide. Open / Amatuer/Junior

- Entries are online at StriderPro
- Entries must include negative Coggins, 6 mo Flu/Rhino certificate, and BGS waiver
- No Refunds unless your spot can be filled from our wait list or the rider has a replacement.
- NO DOGS
- ♦ ASTM/SEI approved helmets must be worn
- Riders must dress in a neat workman like attire for the schooling show. Breeches, jeans, collared shirts are permissible. See RULES for attire. We will not require show jackets.

### **Ribbons**

- ♦ Ribbons will be awarded 1—6,
- ♦ Champion & Reserve will be awarded in divisions with 4 or more participants.

- ♦ All rides are "Order of Go" approximate ride times will be emailed, published on our website and FB page.
- Mandatory course walks with the judge will be scheduled.
- Check final Order of Go at the show office upon check in.


### **General Information**

- ♦ Dressage will be in sand arena adjacent to parking area
- ♦ EOH & Speed in arena next to bank barn
- Warm up in lower jump arena
- No warm up or lunging in parking area
- Clean up all trash, manure, hay etc around your trailer area
- ♦ 6 stalls available. Contact Darcy 610—999-5231 for availability
- Parking easy access in large field
- ♦ Water for horses available
- ♦ Food
- Breakfast: Coffee & Donuts
- Lunch: Pot Luck for judge, participants, and volunteers. Bring your favorite dish to share. We will provide drinks.
